Instead, we hosted an initial on site welcome day where they received a briefing from the monitoring officer and then, in groups, visited stands hosted by directors and other senior officers to have an informal conversation about the services we provide, where no questions were off the table!

At the end of the day, digital services hosted a drop in session to support new members in setting up their devices with their resources.

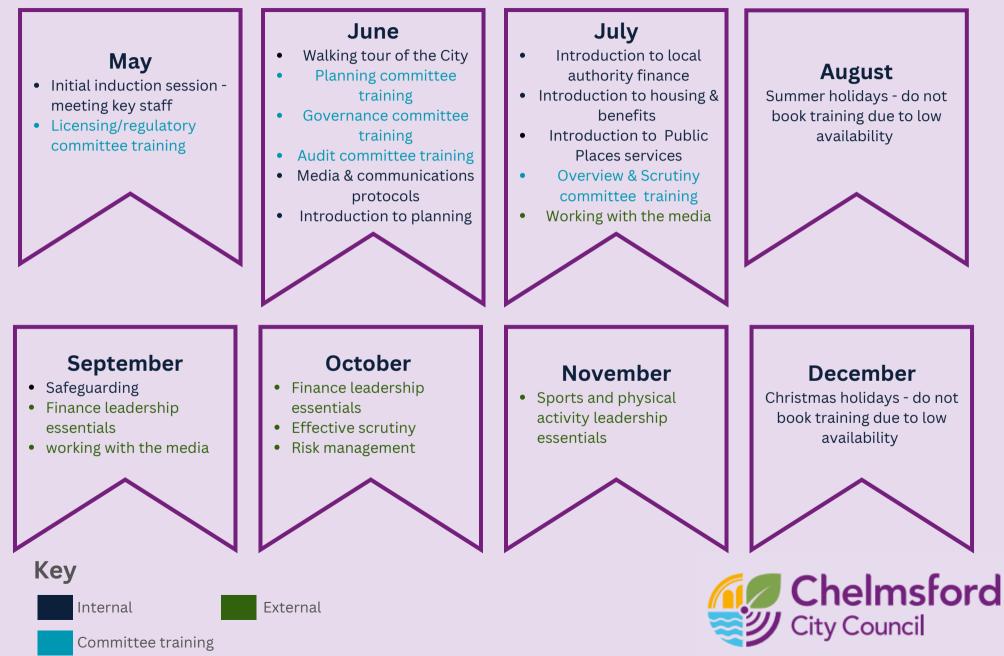
Following this session, specialist training courses are provided throughout the rest of the year (example schedule and online courses outlined below).
