

# MEMBER DEVELOPMENT

In 2023 we listened to feedback from our members and reorganised our induction process. They helped us to understand that for newly elected members a series of detailed presentations is a little overwhelming.

Instead, we hosted an initial on site welcome day where they received a briefing from the monitoring officer and then, in groups, visited stands hosted by directors and other senior officers to have an informal conversation about the services we provide, where no questions were off the table!

At the end of the day, digital services hosted a drop in session to support new members in setting up their devices with their resources.
